Address: Amory st @ Boutwell All Out: Time:Multiple Under Control: Number/Type Apparatus: 1Engine, 1 Ladder, Rescue 1 Number of Alarms: 1 Incident Summary: At 2251 hrs on 1/1/17 MFD responded to an outside fire at 541 Amory st (John and Son's Tire Co). A small pile of clothing/garbage wa ignited in the driveway area. Less than 90 minutes later at 0012 hrs the street box at the corner of Amory and Boutwell St was maliciously pulled and witnesses reported multiple youths fleeing the area prior to MFD arrival. Aproximately 3 hrs later at 0336 a single 911 call reported a tractor trailer on fire at 541 Amory st. Units from Amory St. and Merimack St. arrived to find a box trailer used to store recycled tires well involved in fire. The fire was placed under control in approximately 1 hour and there were no injuries. All 3 events are considered extremely susicious and anyone with further information is advised to contact the MFD Fire Prevention Bureau or the Manchester Police Dept.
