Guidelines

Annual Permits are required to use the facility, with limited exceptions. Permits are good for one year from date of issue. They are sold at the facility only, and may be purchased at the same time as disposal fees are paid. Permits may be revoked for violating guidelines. See reverse side for eligibility requirements.

Asbestos is strictly prohibited.

Automated dump bodies may NOT be used, except to dispose of yard waste.

Batteries are taken, except for lithium non-rechargeable and “button cell”. These are only accepted during household hazardous waste collection events.

Bulky items (non-metal) are furniture, rugs, and other items whose size/weight precludes standard curbside collection. Doors, fixed cabinetry, sinks, and toilets are considered construction/demolition debris and are NOT treated as bulky.

Electronics include, per NH State law: TVs, monitors, computers, and any device that has a video display greater than 4 inches diagonally or is capable of playing/recording analog or digital video.

Fluorescent Lamps must be in-tact. Broken lamps are NOT accepted.

Hazardous Wastes are NOT taken during normal hours, EXCEPT for those identified in the adjacent fee schedule. Additional household hazardous wastes are accepted during special collection events (see reverse side for details).

Oil must be in containers ≤1 gallon, and free of water or other contaminants.

Paint must be LATEX. Oil-based paints are only accepted during household hazardous waste collection events (see reverse side for details). *If wet*, paint must be (a) in containers ≤1 gallon, and (b) in residential quantities. In order to obtain the residential fee waiver for *dried-out* paint, customers must remove container lids PRIOR TO ARRIVAL to allow for inspection.

Recyclables are paper and cardboard; tin; aluminum; glass; and plastics (except for PVC [#3] and “Styrofoam” [#6]). Paper/cardboard must be separated out.

Textiles include clothes, shoes, linens and drapes separated for donation.

Tires from automotive vehicles are eligible for free disposal only if customer provides a current Manchester vehicle registration (copies not accepted). Each set of four free tires requires a unique registration.

Yard Waste must be free of litter and rocks. Compostable materials (leaves, pine needles, grass, etc.) must be separated from brush and logs. Stumps, large roots, soils, gravel, and other fill are NOT accepted.

Note: Capacity is limited. Unusually large loads of any material may be rejected if disposal will unfairly prevent others from using the facility.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Am I eligible for a permit?

Manchester residents, Manchester businesses/non-profits, and outside contractors whose waste has been generated in Manchester are eligible.

Residents

Residential permits are issued to customers who present proof of residency:

- Current driver's license with a Manchester address OR
- Valid photo ID (driver's license or other) AND a recent utility bill, property tax statement, or lease agreement for a Manchester address showing the customer as a resident OR
- Any other proof that, at the sole discretion of the Scale Operator, verifies Manchester residency

Only one permit will be issued per household. Separate units at a single address constitute distinct households and each is eligible for its own permit.

Only individuals RESIDING at the address that is the source of the waste may obtain a residential permit; landlords and property management companies must obtain a commercial permit (see below).

Businesses/Non-Profits

Commercial permits are issued to customers who (a) operate a business or non-profit organization (NPO) in Manchester or (b) are contractors disposing of waste generated within the city limits. Following is sufficient proof:

- Current City of Manchester business license OR
- Recent utility bill, property tax statement, or lease agreement showing a Manchester business/NPO name and address OR
- A recent contract or confirmation letter relevant to the material being dumped that is signed by the owner of a Manchester property OR
- Any other proof that, at the sole discretion of the Scale Operator, verifies that the business/NPO is located in Manchester and/or disposing of waste generated in Manchester

The City reserves the right to reject ANY material from any permitted entity if the material appears to have been generated outside of Manchester.

Which items do not require a permit?

The following "no charge" items do not require a facility permit: mercury thermostats; metal scrap; oil and/or tires *from vehicles registered in Manchester*; rechargeable and lead acid batteries; recyclables; residential, natural Christmas trees; and textile donations.

What are my payment options?

We accept CASH OR CHECK ONLY at the facility. Regular customers who are in good standing and provide a sufficient deposit may establish a charge account. Contact the Department of Public Works at 624-6444 for details.

Why are there restrictions on automated dump bodies?

The use of automated dump bodies increases the risk of: (1) hazardous materials and other contaminants entering the facility's waste streams; and (2) containers being filled inadvertently beyond capacity, resulting in spillage.

When can I dispose of Household Hazardous Wastes?

Household Hazardous Waste Collection Events are held at the Drop Off Facility on the second Saturdays of May and October, from 8 AM to 2 PM. These events are open to Manchester residents only. A facility permit is not required, but participants must bring proof of residency. Disposal is free. Limitations apply. Please visit manchesternh.gov/HHW for more information.

Note that ONLY household hazardous wastes are accepted at these events; other materials – including latex paint, electronics, and tires – are NOT taken.

How much do trash carts cost?

Following are current prices for City of Manchester trash carts:

Do you repair or replace broken trash carts?

Yes, with some limitations. City of Manchester trash carts come with a ten-year warranty against defects from the date of manufacture.

- A cart with damage to just the lid or wheels will be REPAIRED, at no additional charge, REGARDLESS of warranty status.
- A cart with damage to the body is not repairable. It will be REPLACED with a new cart, at no additional charge, IF covered by warranty.

Do you make trash cart deliveries or repairs in the field?

Yes! For an additional fee of \$10 per location, we will go to your home or business to deliver your new cart, replace a damaged cart under warranty, or (when possible) make repairs to your existing cart. There is a maximum of eight carts delivered or serviced per visit.
