


# 2020 Collection Calendar



Trash and recycling services are provided every week, throughout the year. Yard waste services are seasonal.

- Spring and Fall Yard Waste Collection** – Service is WEEKLY, throughout the city
- Curbside Christmas Tree Collection** – First two full weeks of January only; same day as recycling collection; tree must be free of ornamentation
- Household Hazardous Waste Collection Event** – Drop Off Facility, 500 Dunbarton Road, 8am - 2pm. The Drop Off will be closed on July 3 & July 4. Please plan accordingly.
- Collection Holiday** – There is no collection of trash, recycling or yard waste on the holiday. Collection for the remainder of the week is postponed by one day.

- Jan. 1 - New Year's Day
- Feb. 17 - President's Day
- May 25 - Memorial Day
- Sept. 7 - Labor Day
- Oct. 12 - Columbus Day
- Nov. 11 - Veteran's Day
- Nov. 26 - Thanksgiving Day
- Dec. 25 - Christmas Day

## Curbside Collection

The City of Manchester provides curbside collection of:

- Trash
- Recyclables
- Yard waste

Materials must be placed curbside by 7am of your collection day.

Items NOT collected curbside include:

- ✗ Construction/demolition debris
- ✗ Video display units (TVs, monitors, etc.)
- ✗ Hazardous materials/wastes
- ✗ Infectious or radioactive wastes

Trash is picked up by City personnel; recyclables and yard waste are collected by Pinard Waste Systems, under contract.

## Drop Off Facility

The Drop Off Facility at 500 Dunbarton Road provides an alternative disposal option for most wastes and recyclables, including these items not collected curbside:

- ✓ Construction/demolition debris
- ✓ Video display units (TVs, monitors, etc.)
- ✓ Used tires, oils, and propane tanks
- ✓ Fluorescent bulbs and ballasts
- ✓ Wet latex paint

## Household Hazardous Waste

Some common household products that are considered hazardous waste are:

- Anti-freeze
- Cleaners, solvents, and disinfectants
- Drain openers
- Fluorescent bulbs
- Oil-based paints and stains
- Pesticides



These should never be placed in the trash, poured down the drain, or emptied onto the ground – they can contaminate groundwater, damage sewer lines, and impair water bodies.

### Special Collection Events

The Drop Off Facility hosts free Household Hazardous Waste Collection Events each year on the second Saturdays of May and October, 8 AM to 2 PM. Proof of Manchester residency is required. <https://www.manchesternh.gov>

### Helpful Tips

These actions around hazardous household products will help safeguard your family's health and protect natural resources:

- Buy non-toxic alternatives
- Do not burn, bury, pour on ground, pour down drain, or discard in trash
- Store in dry area, away from heat sources
- Keep flammables, corrosives, and poisons in separate cabinets or on separate shelves
- Store in original containers with label
- Give leftover products to friends or local service organizations

## Trash

Following are special rules pertaining to the placement of trash for curbside collection:



**Green trash carts** are now mandatory for all customers. All trash must be placed within your green cart(s), handle facing your property. Need to buy one? [ManchesterNH.gov/trashcarts](https://www.manchesternh.gov/trashcarts)



**Bulky items** are picked up by appointment only. Fees apply. [ManchesterNH.gov/bulky](https://www.manchesternh.gov/bulky)

**Needles and other sharps** must be placed inside a rigid, secured, and labeled container.

## Yard Waste

Yard waste is collected seasonally (see calendar on reverse side).

No branches or stumps greater than 3 inches in diameter or 3 feet in length will be picked up. Acceptable placement methods are:

- Biodegradable paper yard waste bags
- Bundles up to 3 feet long and 2 feet in diameter
- Barrels with an official City yard waste sticker (stickers are available for free at the Public Works offices, 475 Valley Street, and the Drop Off Facility)



Never sweep leaves or brush into the street. Yard waste slows street sweeping equipment and clogs critical storm drain inlets.

## Single Stream Recycling



All of the following items should be placed "loose" in your blue recycling cart:

- ✓ Newspaper, magazines, catalogs
- ✓ Office paper, file folders, envelopes
- ✓ Cardboard, paper towel rolls
- ✓ Metal cans (aluminum, tin, steel)
- ✓ Aluminum foil, trays, pie plates
- ✓ Plastic food/beverage containers
- ✓ Glass bottles & jars

- ✗ **NO** plastic film or bags of any kind (grocery, trash, sandwich, etc.)
- ✗ **NO** styrofoam
- ✗ **NO** batteries or electronics
- ✗ **NO** needles or medical waste
- ✗ **NO** light bulbs, window glass, or mirrors

Please keep Manchester's recyclables free of common materials that contaminate loads and increase costs!

### Guidelines for Collection of Recyclables

- Recyclables **MUST** be placed in your blue cart to be collected.
- Cart must be placed at least two feet from other objects, with handle facing your property.
- Cart must not be blocked on street side.
- A few pieces of excess, flattened cardboard will be accommodated if placed securely on top of the cart, with lid open.
