

Curbside Collection

The City of Manchester provides curbside collection of the following:

- Trash
- Recyclables
- Yard Waste (on a seasonal basis)

Trash collection is performed by City personnel; recycling and yard waste services are provided via contract by Pinard Waste Systems.

Important Reminders

In order to ensure service, materials must be placed curbside by 7:00am on your collection day. In addition, the following guidelines apply:



Bulky Items

Large items, such as furniture and appliances, are picked up curbside by appointment only. There is a \$25 fee and a limit of five items per pickup. Visit

Prohibited Items

Items not collected curbside include asbestos, automotive parts, construction debris, electronic waste, hazardous materials, loose trash, oil, fire

extinguishers, and propane tanks. Hypodermic needles are accepted but must be secured in a rigid container.



Recycling

Manchester is single stream! No sorting is required, but all recyclables must be placed in a blue cart issued by the City.



Yard Waste

Yard waste is collected from mid-April to early December. No branches or stumps greater than 3 inches in diameter or 3 feet in length are collected. The following are acceptable placement methods:

- Bundles up to 3 ft. long and 2 ft. in diameter
- Biodegradable paper yard waste bags
- Barrels with an official City yard waste sticker (stickers are available for free at the Public Works offices, 475 Valley Street, or the Drop Off Facility)

Never sweep leaves or brush into the street. Yard waste slows street sweeping equipment and clogs critical storm drain inlets.

Drop Off Facility

The Drop Off Facility at 500 Dunbarton Road provides an alternative disposal option for most wastes and recyclables, including some materials not collected curbside. For hours of operation, fees, and other information, visit www.ManchesterNH.gov/dropoff, or call (603) 624-6504.

Roll-Out Carts

Green trash carts in 65 and 95 gallon sizes may be purchased at the Drop Off Facility. Carts come with a limited ten-year warranty from the date of manufacture.

Blue recycling carts in 35, 65 and 95 gallon sizes are provided free to eligible customers. Call (603) 413-6799 or visit RecycleManchester.com for more information.

Household Hazardous Waste



Collection Events

The City of Manchester hosts two FREE Household Hazardous Waste Collection Events each year. These events are held at the Drop Off Facility on the second Saturdays

of May and October from 9:00am - 2:00pm. Participants must show proof of residency. Wastes are only accepted in household amounts.

Management of Your Hazardous Wastes

Your actions to minimize the use of toxic household products, and to properly store and dispose of them, will safeguard your family's health and protect natural resources. The following are recommendations:

- Buy non-toxic alternatives when available
- If you have leftover product, consider sharing it with a friend, or donating it to a local service organization
- Never burn, bury, pour on the ground, pour down the drain, or discard in the trash your hazardous waste
- Store hazardous wastes in a dry area away from sources of heat
- Keep flammables, corrosives, and poisons in separate cabinets or on separate shelves
- Always store products in their original containers with the label



- Spring and Fall Yard Waste Cleanup – Weekly collection for entire city
- Mid-Season Yard Waste Cleanup – Collection every other week, as indicated on map
- Curbside Christmas Tree Collection – Same day as recycling; tree must be free of ornamentation
- Household Hazardous Waste Collection Event – Drop Off Facility, 500 Dunbarton Road, 9am to 2pm
- Collection Holiday – Customers whose pickup day falls on a collection holiday should put items out on the following day (even if that day is a Saturday); customers whose pickup day falls later in the week should put items out on their regular day, but may experience collection delays of up to 24 hours
