

BOARD OF RECOUNT

In the absence of a Chairman, the Clerk called the meeting to order and called the roll.

Present: Alderman Shea, Andre Martel and Peter McDonough

The Clerk advised that a motion is in order to elect a Chairman.

On a motion of Alderman Shea, duly seconded by Mr. Martel, it was voted to elect Peter McDonough as Chairman.

Chairman McDonough stated at this point we will go forward in terms of making sure that we have our schedules set. Right now, from the information that I have before me, it looks as though we'll be meeting as follows:

Deputy City Clerk Johnson stated I would like to state for the record that we do in fact have filings for the recounts for the Ward 6 and Ward 12 Aldermanic races and the School Committee race for Ward 3. We received no other applications or proper filings prior to the deadline. Those would be the only three and the Clerk would request the Board consider adopting the Rules of Procedures for Recounts that we have submitted to you. Deputy City Clerk Johnson noted that there would likely be one minor change in the standard teams, and that would be that for the

School Committee race because of space constraints in the Chambers the Clerk's would suggest up to two teams be utilized for that race. The Clerk's office would be working on the set up and notify the candidates accordingly.

On motion of Mr. Martel, duly seconded by Alderman Shea, it was voted to adopt the Rules of Procedures for Recounts with the provision requested by the Clerk so noted.

On motion of Alderman Shea, duly seconded by Mr. Martel, it was voted to accept the two dates listed for the three properly filed recounts.

There being no further business to come before the board, on motion of Mr. Martel, duly seconded by Alderman Shea, it was voted to adjourn.
