


Proposed 2011 Ward Redistricting Map City of Manchester, N. H.

Ward 10 Before Redistricting: 8,599 From Ward 11 to Ward 10: -413 Ward 10 After Redistricting: 9,012 The proposed Ward 10 "After Redistricting" population of 9,012 represents a deviation of 1.3% (+118 persons) from the average 2010 Census ward population of 9,130 persons. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> > 413 persons (in 9 census blocks) are shifted from Ward 11 to Ward 10. > 854 persons (in 24 census blocks) are shifted from Ward 12 to Ward 11. The net population gain for Ward 11 is 441 persons. Ward 11 Before Redistricting: 8,550 From Ward 11 to Ward 10: -413 From Ward 12 to Ward 11: +854 Ward 11 After Redistricting: 8,991 The proposed Ward 11 "After Redistricting" population of 8,991 represents a deviation of 1.5% (+139 persons) from the average 2010 Census ward population of 9,130 persons. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> > 854 persons (in 24 census blocks) are shifted from Ward 12 to Ward 11. Ward 12 Before Redistricting: 9,848 From Ward 12 to Ward 11: -854 Ward 12 After Redistricting: 8,994 The proposed Ward 12 "After Redistricting" population of 8,994 represents a deviation of 1.5% (-136 persons) from the average 2010 Census ward population.

- "Block" boundary lines shown on this map were derived from 2010 Census Redistricting (PL 94-171) TIGER/Line Shapefiles.
- Block population derived from the Census 2010 Redistricting data (PL 94-171) is selectively shown on this map.
- Except for Ward and Block boundary lines, all geographic information shown on this map was derived from the City of Manchester digital base map whose various feature layers are originally based on 1995 and 2003 aerial photography. Some new roads have been constructed in the city since that time and the estimated centerline of some of these new roads have been added to the original base map data. With this in mind, users of this map are cautioned that a small portion of existing roads may not be shown on this map.
- Some roads may have alternative names which are not listed on this map.
