Description of Incident:

1.5 Story cape style house with breezeway and attached garage. Fire started in the rear of the building and communicated to the interior through a sliding door that was left open. Arriving companies encountered significant fire on C side and second floor.

Civilian Injuries: No Civilian Injuries

Emergency Service Injuries: 4 Firefighters were injured at 13:17 when the building experienced a flashover situation. 3 were transported via ambulance.

Special Circumstances:

At 13:17 building experienced a flashover and a mayday was issued for injured firefighters. All members were extricated from the interior by other members and removed from building (13:18) a roll call was taken to ensure all members at scene were accounted for. Injured members were transported to Elliot Hospital to be treated for burns and lacerations.

Cause: Undetermined
