Incident Summary: Single call from the homeowner reporting a smoke condition in the basement. Within 5 minutes Engine 5 from Webster st arrived and reported a heavy smoke condition visible from the exterior of the building and a fire in the basement. Two hoselines were stretched and the fire was extinguished within 60 minutes. Building was searched and ventilated and turned over to the Fire Prevention Bureau for further investigation. Fire does not appear suspicious at this time. No injuries to civilians or firefighters.
