Woman Assaulted During Burglary

A 24-year old Manchester woman was assaulted inside her west side apartment at 11:30 p.m. last night. The victim stated several men broke into her home and assaulted her before fleeing with cash, a gun and a television.

An unknown man allegedly knocked on her door prior to the four men gaining entry through an open window. The four men allegedly caused a laceration to her eye, head and ear after physically assaulting her. She was transported to Catholic Medical Center and treated for her non-life threatening injuries.

She also stated the men removed a handgun from her residence and threatened her with it prior to vacating the apartment. Detectives believe the victim was targeted and do not believe this is a random act of violence. Members of the detective division are following up the case.
