Man Charged with West Street Shooting

The Manchester Police Special Enforcement Division and the Detective Division, along with the Manchester S.W.A.T. team conducted a raid at 273 Belmont Street, 2nd floor at approximately 8:00 p.m. last night. After an investigation regarding the shooting at 91 West Street, they entered the residence and arrested both, John Gebo, 30 of 336 Amherst Street and Kelvin Reddick, 33, No Fixed Address, on arrest warrants for Sale of a Narcotic Drug.

Gebo was also charged with Four Counts of Reckless Conduct and Felon in Possession of a Firearm for his actions on June 8, at 4:02 a.m. when he allegedly fired four bullets into 91 West Street. Detectives on scene also conducted a motor vehicle stop on Belmont Street, near Hayward Street, at the time of the operation and arrested the male passenger of the 2005 Nissan Altima.

Shannon McFarland, 27-years-of-age granted consent to search her motor vehicle. Detectives located a cigarette pack with a used crack pipe inside. The item belonged to her passenger, Brandon Griffin, 28 of 271 Lowell Street. Griffin was charged with Possession of a Controlled Drug and Falsifying Physical Evidence for attempting to conceal the cigarette pack as the officers stopped the vehicle.

All three subjects appeared in the 9th Circuit Court-Manchester earlier today. Detectives are actively investigating the case, so no further details are available at this time.
