#### **Man Arrested After Road Rage Incident Involving a Firearm**

A man and woman from Candia, New Hampshire contacted Manchester Police at 5:40 p.m. after engaging in a road rage type of incident on Huse Road, near Mammoth Road. Joshua Lufbery, 21-years of age was operating a 2006 Hyundai on Huse Road when his traffic light turned green. The operator of a Ford F-250, which was stopped behind his vehicle, allegedly used his horn to have him proceed through the intersection. His actions prompted Lufbery to use a vulgar hand gesture toward the male operator of the pick-up truck.

Both he and his passenger, Danielle King, 23-years of age, continued to drive north on Mammoth Road toward Candia Road. He was stopped at the intersection of Candia Road and Interstate 293 when the same F-250 stopped next to him. The operator, Raymond Desrochers, 56 of Manchester, New Hampshire, pulled alongside them and began yelling and swearing at the two people inside of the car. He allegedly spit on the door, narrowly missing the female passenger.

Lufbery exchanged words with Desrochers as Desrochers exited his vehicle and threw an unknown object at his rear window. The item caused the rear window to break, so Lufbery exited his vehicle as the man got back into his truck and slowly drove away. Lufbery attempted to stop the Desrochers and punched the side of his vehicle as the man refused to stop.

Lufbery got back into his vehicle and followed Desrochers as King called 911. Desrochers stopped on an unknown street as Lufbery proceeded to his driver's side window. Desrochers allegedly exited his truck while pointing a handgun at Lufbery's chest. Lufbery stated he was on the phone with 911 as Desrochers got back into his truck and left the area.

Desrochers was located at his home a short time later. He was in possession of a Smith and Wesson revolver at the time of his arrest. He was charged with Criminal Threatening (F) and Criminal Mischief (M). He was released on \$5,000 cash/surety and is scheduled to appear in the 9<sup>th</sup> Circuit Court-Manchester on August 16, 2016.

**Queen City Man Charged with Two Armed Robberies**

Manchester Police responded to separate armed robberies at Crosstown Variety, 270 Amory Street on May 29<sup>th</sup> and June 5, 2016. Detectives followed up on both cases and ultimately located and arrested Gene Cerra, 31 of 260 Blucher Street, Manchester, New Hampshire.

Officer Brett Fernald located a vehicle matching the description of a possible suspect vehicle on July 10, in front of 260 Blucher Street. Detective Dan Whelan followed up on the lead and ultimately identified Cerra as the party responsible for the armed robberies. He completed an arrest warrant for Cerra and took him into custody at his residence on July 11, 2016.

Cerra is charged with two counts of Armed Robbery (F) and is scheduled to appear in the 9<sup>th</sup> Circuit Court-Manchester on July 12, 2016.
