Just like law enforcement officers, K-9s have the potential of being shot at and exposed to narcotics on the job. It's highly unlikely that paramedics or other first responders would be able to help with canine trauma. This training could assist officers in learning what to do in the few critical minutes after an animal is hurt, time that could decide whether they live or die.
