Report of the Committee on Administration/Information Systems recommending that a request from the taxi industry to increase the current taxi rates from \$.25 per 1/6<sup>th</sup> of a mile to \$.40 per 1/6<sup>th</sup> of a mile be approved. The Committee has requested that representatives from the local taxi businesses return by the end of January, 2009 to revisit this temporary increase.  
**(If the Board so desires a motion is in order to accept the report, and to suspend the rules and place the ordinance on its final reading at this time without referral to the Committee on Bills on Second Reading or the Committee on Enrollment; following which a motion shall be in order that the Ordinance be ordained.)**

**To the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Manchester:**

The Committee on Administration/Information Systems respectfully recommends, after due and careful consideration, that a request to increase current taxi rates from \$.25 per one-sixth of a mile to \$.40 per one-sixth of a mile be approved. The Committee further notes that this ordinance amendment, if approved, shall expire on January 30, 2009.

## AN ORDINANCE

“Amending the Code of Ordinances of the City of Manchester by amending §118.33 (A) Rates For Fares Established, by increasing the current taxi rates from \$.25 per one-sixth of a mile to \$.40 per one-sixth of a mile.”

BE IT ORDAINED, By the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Manchester, as follows:

- I. Amend the Code of Ordinances by inserting new language as bolded (**bold**), and deleting existing language as ~~struckthrough~~. Portions of the following sections that remain unchanged appear in regular type.

### § 118.33 RATES FOR FARES ESTABLISHED.

No owner or driver of a taxicab shall charge any passenger or passengers any rate for service within the limits of the city other than is provided for in this section or as allowed by § 118.34 of this subchapter.

(A) Metered fares. For the first one-sixth mile or fraction thereof for one passenger, \$3; and for each one-sixth mile or fraction thereof thereafter, ~~\$.25~~ **\$.40**; and for each additional passenger, \$.25.

- II. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and expire January 30, 2009.
