**January 19, 1999**

**Upon Recess of BMA**

Chairman Hirschmann called the meeting to order.

The Clerk called the roll.

**Present:** Aldermen Hirschmann, Rivard, Thibault, Girard, O'Neil

Chairman Hirschmann advised Ordinances were to be considered for consistency with the rules of the Board, and required laws, and requested the Clerk make a presentation relative to Ordinances:

“Amending the Code of Ordinances of the City of Manchester by deleting a portion of 110.02(C), License and Business Regulations, providing for changes in licensing regulations.”

“Amending the Code of Ordinances of the City of Manchester by repealing Chapter 116, Alcoholic Beverages, providing for local regulation of establishments selling, dispensing, or distributing alcoholic beverages.”

“Forbidding the Possession of a Dangerous Weapon on School Property.”

“To establish means to prevent, prohibit and remove graffiti from structures and surfaces on public and private property in the City of Manchester.”

“Authorizing the Mayor to dispose of certain tax deeded property known as Map 222, Lot 52 in the vicinity of River Road and Chestnut Street.”

“Authorizing the Mayor to dispose of certain tax deeded property known as Map 222, Lot 79 in the vicinity of River Road and Chestnut Street.”

“An Ordinance amending Chapter 35, Finance, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Manchester, by increasing limits on Sec. 35.097, Small Purchases, under the provisions of the City Procurement Code.”

Deputy Clerk Johnson advised of the processes followed with regard to each of the ordinances.

Chairman Hirschmann noted that everything being in order a motion was in order.

On motion of Alderman Thibault, duly seconded by Alderman Rivard, it was voted to advise that the ordinances were properly enrolled.

Alderman Girard stated Alderman Pariseau had a question regarding the Ordinance “forbidding the Possession of a Dangerous Weapon on School Property.” and I believe it’s the Alderman’s intent to amend that Ordinance of he would like to amend that Ordinance to including “*other public buildings*”. I know it can’t be done here in Committee, my question is whether or not at this stage in the process the Ordinance can be amended at the Board once we report out.

Chairman Hirschmann asked would the Clerk please advise on the Alderman’s question.

Deputy Clerk Johnson advised that after consultation with the City Solicitor that that change can be made, but not obviously in Committee, it can be made at the Board level.

There being no further business to come before the Committee, on motion of Alderman Thibault, duly seconded by Alderman Rivard, it was voted to adjourn.
