

**COMMITTEE ON ACCOUNTS, ENROLLMENT
AND REVENUE ADMINISTRATION**

October 1, 2002

Chairman Shea called the meeting to order.

The Clerk called the roll.

Present: Aldermen Shea, Guinta, Smith, Thibault and Lopez

Chairman Shea advised that Ordinances are to be considered for consistency with the rules of the Board, and required laws, and requested the Clerk to make a presentation relative to the Ordinances:

“Amending the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Manchester by changing the zoning district of property currently zoned R-SM (Residential Suburban Multifamily District) to B-2 (General Business District) on the west side of Brown Avenue at the intersection of Hazelton Avenue.”

“Amending the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Manchester by changing the zoning district of property currently zoned R-1B (Residential One Family District) to R-SM (Residential Suburban Multifamily District) on the east side of Brown Avenue at the intersection of Hazelton Avenue, extending to the Londonderry Town line.”

Deputy Clerk Johnson stated the Clerk would advise that both ordinances are zoning ordinances. Both were introduced to the Board of Mayor and Aldermen. They were referred to the Committee on Bills on Second Reading who reported out a desire to hold a public hearing. The public hearing was held by the Board. The Committee on Bills on Second Reading subsequently reviewed it and recommended that it ought to pass. There was an amendment to one of the ordinances and that report was accepted by the Board and the Board has enrolled it this evening and in our opinion it is properly enrolled.

On motion of Alderman Smith, duly seconded by Alderman Guinta, it was voted to advise that the Ordinances presented are properly enrolled.

There being no further business, on motion of Alderman Smith, duly seconded by Alderman Lopez, it was voted to adjourn.
