On motion of Alderman Sysyn, duly seconded by Alderman Shea, it was voted to enter into executive session under the provisions of RSA-91:A-3 Paragraph 2 (c) to discuss the denial of a license to operate a taxicab.

A roll call vote was taken with all present voting in the affirmative with the exception of Alderman Elise who arrived late.

Mr. Bergeron opened the discussion in defense of his position relative to the sexual harassment complaint.

Mr. Normand updated the Committee relative to Mr. Bergeron.

Det. Brennan explained to the Committee that he had interviewed the individual who had issued the complaint against Mr. Bergeron giving a brief outline as to what had transpired at that time.

Atty. Bandazian asked Mr. Normand on what basis his client's application to operate a taxicab revoked.

Mr. Normand referred to Section 118-16 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Manchester.

Det. Brennan provided a more detailed account as documented in his report submitted regarding the complaint.

Attorney Bandazian on behalf of his client provided the Committee with a brief statement relative to their position with respect to the complaint.

Mr. Young a dispatcher from Town & Country stated he had never received any complaints against Mr. Bergeron from any other customers in the past.

Lt. Tessier noted his concerns relative to this matter and hoped that the Committee would act accordingly.

Attorney Bandazian stated the trial had been scheduled for January 29, 1998.

The Committee voted unanimously to revoke Mr. Bergeron's license to operate a taxicab noting that after a decision has been rendered through the court system, Mr. Bergeron may then appear before the Committee at that time.

On motion of Alderman Sysyn, duly seconded by Alderman Hirschmann, it was voted to return to public session.

There being no further business to come before the Committee on motion of Alderman Shea, duly seconded by Alderman Elise, it was voted to adjourn.
