

## COMMITTEE ON ADMINISTRATION/INFORMATION SYSTEMS

**March 23, 1998**

**6:15 PM**

Chairman Pariseau called the meeting to order.

The Clerk called the roll.

**Present:** Aldermen Pariseau, Rivard, Girard, O'Neil. Alderman Thibault arrived at 6:25 p.m.

The Chairman explained that the purpose of the meeting was to listen to an appeal of a taxicab driver whose license had been revoked by the City Clerk. In the past, he said, the Committee would meet with the driver in executive session. The Clerk would explain the reason for the revocation, and the driver would have an opportunity to explain his or her side of the story. Afterward, the driver would be told to call the City Clerk's Office the next day for the Committee's decision. After the driver has had her say, the matter would be discussed without the person present, and a decision reached.

The Chairman invited Oliviamarie Zielinski in to the meeting.

A motion was made by Alderman O'Neil, seconded by Alderman Girard, to enter into non-public session under the provisions of RSA-91:A-3 Paragraph 2(c) to discuss the revocation of a license to operate a taxicab. Motion carried.

The Clerk explained that Ms. Zielinski was a new licensee who had been ordered to take a random drug test and that the results of the test came back positive. Ms. Zielinski discussed her situation and the test, and responded to questions posed by the Committee.

Alderman Rivard moved that the Committee return to public session. Motion was duly seconded by Alderman O'Neil. Motion carried.

Alderman Thibault moved that the City Clerk's decision to revoke the taxicab driver's license of Oliviamarie Zielinski be sustained and that said license be revoked. Motion was duly seconded by Alderman O'Neil. Motion carried.

There being no further business, Alderman Rivard moved that the meeting adjourn. Motion was duly seconded by Alderman Thibault. Motion carried.
