

COMMITTEE ON ADMINISTRATION/INFORMATION SYSTEMS

Chairman Gatsas called the meeting to order.

The Clerk called the roll.

Present: Aldermen Gatsas, Pariseau, Hirschmann, O'Neil

Absent: Alderman Thibault

Also present were Aldermen Levasseur, Pinard, Cashin and Lopez.

Chairman Gatsas addressed Item 5 of the agenda first:

5. Communication from Fred Harris, President of Riverfest, Inc., seeking permission of various requests as outlined below during the Riverfest celebration scheduled for September 8, 9 & 10, 2000:
 - (a) designation of the area generally bordered by Elm Street to the east, Brook Street to the north, Granite Street to the south, and the Merrimack River to the west as the "Riverfest Area"; and
 - (b) requesting that the City Clerk be instructed not to issue permits to any vendors in this area during the celebration.

On motion of Alderman Pariseau, duly seconded by Alderman Hirschmann, it was voted to approve requests as outlined for the Riverfest celebration.

Chairman Gatsas addressed item 6 of the agenda next:

6. Application from Steven Schubert requesting a carnival license from April 13-23, 2000 for the annual Spring Carnival to be held at Singer Family Park, all proceeds to benefit the Central High School Gridiron Club.

On motion of Alderman O'Neil, duly seconded by Alderman Pariseau, it was voted to approve the request for a carnival license.

Chairman Gatsas addressed an item of new business:

Application from Guild Hill requesting a circus license on behalf of the Bektash Temple to be held at the JFK Coliseum from April 6-9, 2000.

On motion of Alderman Pariseau, duly seconded by Alderman O'Neil, it was voted to approve the request for a circus license.

Alderman Pariseau moved to recess the regular meeting to meet with legal counsel in accordance with RSA 91-A:2 (c). Alderman O'Neil duly seconded the motion. There being none opposed, the motion carried.

Chairman Gatsas called the meeting back to order.

The Clerk noted for the record that the members of the Committee have met with legal counsel and have directed the Clerk to request City departments to respond to the City Solicitor's Office within two weeks to a previous survey sent relating to cable services, MCTV and the I-Net.

On motion of Alderman O'Neil, duly seconded by Alderman Pariseau, it was voted to refer the document presented this evening as amended by legal counsel to the full Board of Mayor and Aldermen at their next regularly scheduled meeting of March 7, 2000.

There being no further business to come before the Committee, on motion of Alderman Pariseau, duly seconded by Alderman O'Neil, it was voted to adjourn.
