

## COMMITTEE ON ADMINISTRATION/INFORMATION SYSTEMS

Chairman Gatsas called the meeting to order.

The Clerk called the roll.

**Present:** Aldermen Gatsas, Pariseau, Thibault, Hirschmann, O'Neil

Chairman Gatsas addressed Item 4 of the agenda:

Discussion of changes to Vehicles for Hire ordinance under consideration  
by Bills on Second Reading.

On motion of Alderman Pariseau, duly seconded by Alderman O'Neil, it was voted to table this item.

Chairman Gatsas addressed Items 3 and 5 of the agenda:

3. Appeal of taxi business license revocation.
5. A motion is in order to enter non-public session to discuss appeals of denial of taxi driver's licenses:
  - a) Request of 1/28/00
  - b) Request of 2/15/00
  - c) Request of 3/8/00

Alderman Hirschmann moved to enter non-public session under the provisions of RSA-91:A-3 paragraph 2(c) to discuss the revocation of a taxi business license and the appeal of a denial of a taxi driver's license. Alderman O'Neil duly seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken. There being none opposed, the motion carried.

On motion of Alderman Pariseau, duly seconded by Alderman O'Neil, it was voted to return to public session.

Non-public session ensued with Mr. Hamel, the operator; Mr. Normand, License Enforcement Inspector; Atty. Muller, City Solicitor's Office; Sgt. Winn, Manchester Police Department committee members and the Clerk present. Mr. Hamel withdrew his appeal. Only one operator, Mr. Jubrey, showed up to appeal the denial of his taxi license. The Committee affirmed the decision by the Office of the City Clerk to deny the application. Mr. Jubrey may not reapply for a taxi license until January 25, 2004.

There being no further business to come before the Committee, on motion of Alderman Pariseau, duly seconded by Alderman Thibault, it was voted to adjourn.
