**COMMITTEE ON BILLS ON SECOND READING**

Chairman Wihby called the meeting to order.

Present: Ald. Wihby, Elise, Clancy, Pariseau, Cashin

Chairman Wihby addressed item 3 of the agenda:

3. Ordinance:

"Amending Section 18-25 (Video Technician/Productions Coordinator) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Manchester."

On motion of Ald. Cashin, duly seconded by Ald. Pariseau, it was voted to recommend that the Ordinance ought to pass.

Chairman Wihby addressed item 4 of the agenda:

4. Dog Fouling Ordinance amendment referred to Committee by the Committee on Administration/Information Systems.

Chairman Wihby advised the main focus of the change was to require a scooper to be carried.

On motion of Ald. Pariseau, duly seconded by Ald. Clancy, it was voted to recommend that the ordinance ought to pass.

Chairman Wihby addressed item 5 of the agenda:

5. Proposed amendment to compensation for boards and commissions of the City of Manchester referred to Committee by the Committee on Finance.

Ald. Cashin questioned the amount of savings involved. Chairman Wihby advised it was approximately \$15,000. Ald. Cashin commented that he felt they should not remove the compensation to the commissions noting it wasn't a matter of money, but with the time involved it was a token and should remain; that if the city had to balance the budget based on commission pays of \$150 or so a year then they had many troubles.

It was noted that some of these items would require ordinance changes and those would need to be prepared.

Ald. Pariseau felt a special committee should be established by the board to review the reimbursements noting there were different amounts for various boards and commissions.

Chairman Wihby suggested it be forwarded to the solicitor for review noting he may return and tell us we can't do some of it, and if they were changed it was not the intent to remove travel reimbursements.

On motion of Ald. Pariseau, duly seconded by Ald. Cashin, it was voted to refer the item to the solicitor for ordinance review.

Chairman Wihby addressed item 6 of the agenda:

6. Proposed City penalties referred to Committee by the Committee on Traffic/Public Safety.

Chairman Wihby advised that the police department wished to further review this item and had requested it be tabled.

On motion of Ald. Pariseau, duly seconded by Ald. Cashin, it was voted to table this item.

Chairman Wihby addressed item 7 of the agenda:

7. Petition to rezone a certain parcel of land located near Bremer Street and Coolidge Avenue submitted by Attorney Martin Jenkins.

On motion of Ald. Pariseau, duly seconded by Ald. Cashin, it was voted to recommend the petition be referred to public hearing during the last week of July at a date to be determined by the City Clerk.

Chairman Wihby addressed item 8 of the agenda:

8. Communication from Ald. Elise relative to the proposed Heritage Commission Ordinance.  
(Note: communication from Planning Director enclosed.)

Ald. Elise advised she had met with Planning and the Historic Commission and was submitting proposed amendments as a result for the committee's consideration at its next meeting to allow time for review of the amendments.

On motion of Ald. Clancy, duly seconded by Ald. Pariseau, it was voted to table this item pending further review of the amendments presented.
