

## COMMITTEE ON BILLS ON SECOND READING

Chairman Wihby called the meeting to order.

The Clerk called the roll.

Present: Aldermen Wihby, Sysyn, Clancy, Pinard, Cashin

Chairman Wihby advised that the first purpose of the meeting shall be organizational in nature, and requested the Clerk to provide a brief overview regarding typical issues addressed by the Committee.

Deputy Clerk Johnson advised that this committee primarily handled technical review of ordinances. The committee may at times consider amendments to the ordinances to address corrections needed. Additionally, amendments to zoning ordinances would be reviewed and considered for recommendation of public hearings. If the ordinances need further preparation or review the solicitor or city clerk's office might request the committee to table the item pending further review or preparation.

4. Ordinance:

"Amending the Code of Ordinances of the City of Manchester by adding a new Section 130.42, Establishing Public Housing Drug Free Zones."

On motion of Alderman Cashin, duly seconded by Alderman Sysyn, it was voted to recommend that the ordinance ought to pass.

5. Communication from Steve Forbes requesting that an ordinance on Light Pollution and Light Trespass be adopted.

On motion of Alderman Clancy, duly seconded by Alderman Sysyn, it was voted to refer this item to the Planning Board for review and report.

### **TABLED ITEMS**

6. Ordinance Amendments relating to a petition to rezone property submitted by residents in the Brown Avenue area:

“Amending the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Manchester by creating a B-3 (Highway Business) zoning district to include land currently zoned R-1B and located between Brown Avenue and Whalley Road, from Dixwell Street southerly to Trafford Street.”

“Amending the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Manchester by creating a B-3 (Highway Business) zoning district to include land currently zoned R-1B and located on Brown Avenue from Trafford Street southerly to Coldwell Street including the following lots: Tax Map 675, Lots No. 1, 2, 3, 4, & 5; Tax Map 683, Lots No. 5, 6, 7, 7A, 8, 8A, 9, 10 & 11.”

“Amending the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Manchester by creating a B-3 (Highway Business) zoning district to include land currently zoned R-1B, located on the east side of Brown Avenue, south of Trafford Street, including the following lots: Tax Map 750, Lots No. 22, 23, 23A, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28 & 30.”

Mr. Dillon advised that they were still working with the neighborhood regarding issues in the Brown Avenue area.

This item remained on the table.

7. Ordinance:

"An Ordinance amending Chapter 118, Vehicles for Hire, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Manchester, Sections 118.01, 118.15, 118.16, 118.33, 118.34, 118.37, 118.39, and 118.99 relative to taxicab definitions, regulations, fares, and penalties."

8. Proposed leash ordinance
