

BOARD OF REGISTRARS

October 27, 1997

12:00 PM

Chairman Brack called the meeting to order.

Clerk Pepino called the roll.

Present: Rita Brack, Leo Bernier, Brian McHugh and Rita Pepino

Absent: Richard Fradette

Chairman Brack introduced Mr. Brian McHugh, the newest member of the Board of Registrars having been confirmed on October 7, 1997 and presented him with those documents relative to the State Statutes as well as voter checklist, etc.

Chairman Brack advised that the first purpose of the meeting is to accept the voter checklists dated October 9, 1997 as presented previously due to the purging of voter checklists.

On motion of Mrs. Pepino, duly seconded by Mr. Bernier, it was voted to accept the voter checklist dated October 9, 1997 as presented.

Chairman Brack advises that the second purpose of the meeting is to accept the changes to the voter checklists with any updates, additions and/or deletions between October 9-25, 1997.

A brief presentation was made to Mr. McHugh relative to the procedures followed with respect to updates, additions and/or deletions made to the voter checklists.

On motion of Mrs. Pepino, duly seconded by Dr. Brack, it was voted to accept the changes to the voter checklists made between October 9-25, 1997 as submitted.

Mrs. Pepino stated she would be willing to reviewing the obituaries appearing in the local newspaper on a regular basis in order to submit them to the Clerk's Office for removal from the voter checklists.

Those members in attendance indicated their consent to such.

Chairman Brack explained to Mr. McHugh the process involved relative to the recent purging of the voter checklists noting there had been approximately 12,000 names deleted from the list as of Friday, October 10th. Of the 13,887 letters that were sent out to voters, eighty percent were returned via the U.S. Postal Service as either undeliverable, not at this address, forwarding address expired, etc. Chairman Brack noted that during the months of September and October, approximately 1,500 changes to the voter registration lists had been made.

There being no further business to come before the Board of Registrars, on motion of Mrs. Pepino, duly seconded by Dr. Brack, it was voted to adjourn.
