

## BOARD OF REGISTRARS

**June 7, 2001**

**12:00 PM**

Chairman Pepino called the meeting to order.

The Clerk called the roll.

**PRESENT:** Barbara Arnold, Leo Bernier and Rita Pepino

**ABSENT:** Dr. Rita Brack and Brian McHugh

**MESSRS:** Tricia Piecuch

Chairman Pepino addressed item 3 of the agenda:

Acceptance of voter checklist (additions, deletions and changes) from May 1, 2001 to May 31, 2001.

On motion of Ms. Arnold, duly seconded by Mr. Bernier, it was voted to accept the changes to the checklist from May 1, 2001 to May 31, 2001. There being none opposed the motion carried.

Chairman Pepino addressed item 4 of the agenda:

Approval of deletions from the checklist relating to the purging of the checklist pursuant to RSA 654:39 and to certify the checklist for the City of Manchester.

Deputy Clerk Piecuch advised the Board that there had been a problem with the system in running the purge listing. She stated that on June 7, 2001 she was made aware that there were 1,212 other voters (handout provided) who needed to be purge and that she was working with the Information Systems Department in getting the letters out for those individuals by Friday, June 8, 2001. She asked that the Board accept the changes, including the 6,532 voters deleted as the result of the first mailing of the purge, in the checklist from June 1, 2001 to June 6, 2001. She stated that at this time they didn't need to certify the checklist as they needed to wait until the second mailing was completed which would be on July 17, 2001.

Chairman Pepino asked if we would still fall into the guidelines set by the State.

Deputy Clerk Piecuch replied yes, that the Board had until September 1, 2001 to certify the checklist and that we would like to schedule a meeting in July to complete the process and have the checklist certified at that time.

Mr. Bernier asked if July 18, 2001 at 12:00 PM would be a good time.

Ms. Pepino and Ms. Arnold replied in the affirmative.

Deputy Clerk Piecuch noted that she would forward out to the Board members not in attendance the copies of the deletions as well as the new handout of voters needing to be purged.

On motion of Mr. Bernier, duly seconded by Ms. Arnold it was voted to accept the checklist changes, including deletions from the first mailing of the purge, from June 1, 2001 to June 6, 2001. There being none opposed the motion carried.

There being no further business to come before the Board of Registrars, on motion of Mr. Bernier, duly seconded by Ms. Arnold, it was voted to adjourn.
