

## BOARD OF REGISTRARS

**July 18, 2001**

**12:00 PM**

Chairman Pepino called the meeting to order.

The Clerk called the roll.

**PRESENT:** Barbara Arnold, Leo R. Bernier, Rita Pepino

**ABSENT:** Dr. Rita Brack and Brian McHugh

Chairman Pepino addressed item 3 of the agenda:

Acceptance of voter checklist (additions, deletions and changes) from June 1, 2001 to June 30, 2001.

On motion of Mr. Bernier, duly seconded by Ms. Arnold, it was voted to accept the changes in the voter checklist from June 1, 2001 to June 30, 2001. There being none opposed the motion carried.

Chairman Pepino addressed item 4 of the agenda:

Approval of deletions from the checklist relating to the purging of the checklist pursuant to RSA 654:39 and to certify the checklist for the City of Manchester.

Deputy Clerk Piecuch stated the purge of the City of Manchester voters is now completed. We had sent out a total of over 7700 letters, in two mailings, to the residents and have deleted those who did not come into our office to re-register. Deputy Clerk Piecuch handed out the voter registration updates from July 1, 2001 to July 18, 2001, which included over 1,100 deletes relating to the purge and asked for a motion to accept these changes.

On motion of Ms. Arnold, duly seconded by Mr. Bernier, it was voted to accept the changes to the checklist from July 1, 2001 to July 18, 2001, which also included the final purged voters. There being none opposed the motion carried.

Deputy Clerk Piecuch stated I would also accept a motion to certify that the City of Manchester's checklist is in compliance with State law (RSA 654:39) relative the 10-year purge and request the members to sign the certification, which needs to be forwarded to the Secretary of State's Office prior to September 1, 2001.

On motion of Ms. Arnold, duly seconded by Mr. Bernier, it was voted to certify, in compliance with State Law (RSA 654:39), the City of Manchester checklist. There being none opposed, the motion carried.

Chairman Pepino asked does anyone have anything else to come before the Board? I would like to ask that the members of the Board of Registrars receive an alpha checklist for their files since the purge has been completed.

Deputy Clerk Piecuch stated she would print the report and forward it to all Board members.

There being no further business to come before the Board of Registrars, on motion of Mr. Bernier, duly seconded by Ms. Arnold it was vote to adjourn.
