

## BOARD OF REGISTRARS

**August 21, 2001**

**12:00 PM**

Chairman Pepino called the meeting to order.

The Clerk called the roll.

Present: Barbara Arnold, Tricia Piecuch (representing Leo Bernier), Dorothy Krasner, Rita Pepino

Absent: Brian McHugh, Leo Bernier

Deputy Clerk Piecuch introduced Dorothy Krasner as the new member of the Board of Registrars.

Chairman Pepino addressed item 3 of the agenda:

Acceptance of voter checklist (addition, deletions and changes) from July 1, 2001 to July 31, 2001.

Ms. Arnold questioned the deletion of a Patricia Dastin from the voter checklist.

Deputy Clerk Piecuch explained that Ms. Dastin had been purged; that we had sent a letter for her to come into the office to re-register and she failed to comply with that request.

On motion of Ms. Arnold, duly seconded by Ms. Krasner, it was voted to accept the changes in the checklist as presented to the Board. There being none opposed the motion carried.

Chairman Pepino addressed item 4 of the agenda:

Copy of a communication dated July 20, 2001 forwarded to Mark D. Roberts relative to his official residence.

Deputy Clerk Piecuch explained that we had received a verbal communication that Mr. Roberts no longer lived at 77 Market Street. In following with State law we

sent Mr. Roberts a letter, both certified and regular. This was a concern as Mr. Roberts had filed to run for Alderman in Ward 3 in the Non-Partisan Municipal Primary Election. Deputy Clerk Piecuch noted we had received the certified card back signed by someone other than Mr. Roberts and that we received the regular letter back with an address of 1506 Valley Place, Homewood, AL 35209. Deputy Clerk Piecuch further stated that Mr. Roberts did contact her and explained that he moved out of state at the last minute and would send us a letter stating that, so that he could be removed from the ballot, which when we received notification we had his name removed prior to printing of the ballot.

On motion of Ms. Arnold, duly seconded by Ms. Krasner, it was voted to remove Mark D. Roberts from voter registration and also the ballot. There being none opposed, the motion carried.

#### New Business

Deputy Clerk Piecuch asked if all members present would sign a blank piece of paper as she needed to have new Board of Registrars stamps made due to the change in membership and that she would contact Mr. McHugh to have him come and in sign.

Chairman Pepino asked when the next meeting would be.

Deputy Clerk Piecuch stated it would probably be September 10<sup>th</sup> as the Board will need to meet prior to the Non-Partisan Primary Election.

There being no further business to come before the Board, on motion of Ms. Arnold, duly seconded by Ms. Krasner, it was voted to adjourn.
