

## BOARD OF REGISTRARS

**September 10, 2001**

City Clerk Leo Bernier called the meeting to order in absence of Chairman Pepino and asked for a motion to elect a Chairman Pro-Tem. On motion of Mr. Bernier, duly seconded by Ms. Krasner, it was voted to elect Ms. Arnold as Chairman Pro-Tem. There being none opposed the motion carried.

Chairman Arnold addressed item 3 of the agenda:

Deputy Clerk Piecuch explained to Ms. Krasner the way the voter registration reports are done and further explained about the dates of adding or updating noting that if someone requests an absentee ballot they will appear on this report with an updated date.
