

## BOARD OF REGISTRARS

**October 29, 2001**

**12:00 PM**

Chairman Pepino called the meeting to order.

The Clerk called the roll.

Chairman Pepino addressed Item 3 of the agenda:

Acceptance of voter checklist (addition, deletions and changes) from  
September 9, 2001 to October 27, 2001.

On motion of Barbara Arnold, duly seconded by Dorothy Krasner, it was voted to accept the changes to the voter checklist. There being none opposed the motion carried.

Chairman Pepino addressed Item 4 of the agenda:

Copy of a communication dated October 2, 2001 forwarded to  
Mr. Rob Thompson relative to his official residence.

Chairman Pepino stated well he has changed his residence.

Deputy Clerk Piecuch stated he has responded and come in and made the necessary changes and that you accepted this change in Item 3.

On motion of Barbara Arnold, duly seconded by Dorothy Krasner, it was voted to receive and file this item. There being none opposed, the motion carried.

Chairman Pepino addressed Item 5 of the agenda:

Copy of communication received from Representative Marc Pappas questioning the residency of former Congressman Norm D'Amours and his wife.

Deputy Clerk Leblond-Kang stated Mr. Bernier has indicated and recommends that Item 5 be referred to the City Solicitor's Office for his review and report back to the Board of Registrars.

On motion of Dorothy Krasner, duly seconded by Barbara Arnold it was voted to refer this item to the City Solicitor. There being none opposed, the motion carried.

Chairman Pepino addressed Item 6 of the agenda:

Copy of a communication from Mr. Rob Thompson challenging the residences of Theresa Daniel, Joanna Paradise, Tanya Soucy, Clarrisse Jensen, Rita Robidoux, Kathleen Hardy and Barry & Lisa Ritchie, and requesting that Henry Thibault's legal residence be verified.

Deputy Clerk LeBlond-Kang stated again on this item Mr. Bernier is recommending that the residences of Daniel, Paradise, Soucy, Jensen, Robidoux, Hardy and the Ritchie's follow the same procedures where a letter would be sent to them.

Ms. Arnold asked don't we send a letter establishing a residence and they have 30 days to respond.

Deputy Clerk LeBlond-Kang answered that is correct. That would be the first motion on this one.

On motion of Dorothy Krasner, duly seconded by Barbara Arnold, it was voted to send letters to those listed above per State law. There being none opposed, the motion carried.

Deputy Clerk LeBlond-Kang stated as far as the request regarding Henry Thibault's legal residence and that it be verified, Mr. Bernier has recommended that this item also be referred to the City Solicitor for his review.

On motion of Barbara Arnold, duly seconded by Dorothy Krasner it was voted to refer the issue of Henry Thibault's legal residence to the City Solicitor. There being none opposed, the motion carried.

Ms. Krasner asked regarding the items that were referred to the City Solicitor, will he report back to this Committee.

Deputy Clerk LeBlond-Kang replied yes, that will go out under Mr. Bernier's signature on behalf of the Board of Registrar's Office with a request that he report back to us at which point Mr. Bernier will get in touch and let each Board member know what the results were.

Deputy Clerk Piecuch asked at the same time would you like to set a date for the next meeting because the letter has to specify the date and time of the next meeting. Would you like to make a date now? We have to give them at least 30 days. Right now we are looking at October 29<sup>th</sup> so how is November 29<sup>th</sup>.

Chairman Pepino asked would the letters go out today.

Deputy Clerk Piecuch answered no they would not go out today. We would be looking at the first week of December for a meeting date. How about December 3<sup>rd</sup>? We will have the letters out this week and that will give them 30 days to respond and we will meet again on December 3<sup>rd</sup> at 12 noon.

The members present were in agreement.

There being no further business, on motion of Barbara Arnold, duly seconded by Dorothy Krasner, it was voted to adjourn. There being none opposed the motion carried.
