Chairman McHugh called the meeting to order.

The Clerk called the roll.

Chairman McHugh addressed Item 3 of the agenda:

Acceptance of voter checklist (additions, deletions and changes) from September 7, 2003 to October 27, 2003.

On motion of Ms. Arnold, duly seconded by Mr. Bernier, it was voted to accept the additions, deletions and changes to the checklist from September 7, 2003 through October 27, 2003. There being none opposed, the motion carried.

Chairman McHugh addressed Item 4 of the agenda:

Authorization to hire Gregory Reynolds as Acting Moderator in Ward 1 and permission to replace Moderator in Ward 7 with an Acting Moderator, Joseph LaFrance if Moderator is unable to work on Election Day pursuant to RSA 669:62.

Mr. Bernier stated that it was the Board that needed to authorize these appointments and that there could possibly be a vacancy in Ward 7 due to an illness in the family of the current Moderator.

On motion of Mr. Bernier, duly seconded by Ms. Pepino, it was voted to hire Gregory Reynolds as Acting Moderator in Ward 1 and to hire, if needed, Joseph LaFrance as Acting Moderator in Ward 7. There being none opposed, the motion carried.

Deputy Clerk Piecuch updated the Board regarding party affiliation changes as the last day to accept these changes would be Friday, October 31, 2003 as the filing period for the Presidential Primary starts on Monday, November 3, 2003. She noted that if anyone wanted to change party affiliation the City Clerk's Office would be opened on October 31, 2003 until 7:30 PM. If individuals failed to change their party before then, they would have to wait until after the Presidential Primary on January 27, 2004. She also informed the Board she had done a show on MCTV explaining the November election and did bring up the changing of the party affiliation timeframe.

There being no further business to come before the Board, on motion of Mr. Bernier, duly seconded by Ms. Arnold, it was voted to adjourn. There being none opposed the motion carried.
