

Refuse Guidelines

Important Curbside Collection Rules

- Place refuse at the edge of the roadway; do not block sidewalks.
- Do not put refuse out for collection prior to 4 PM of the day preceding your scheduled collection day.
- Yard waste must be separated from garbage (see yard waste section of this guide for details).
- For those participating in recycling, recyclables must be placed in a blue recycling cart (see www.recyclemanchester.com for more details).
- For the safety of collection crews, syringes must be placed in a rigid, secured container.
- Bulky Item Pickup – Bulky items, which include furniture, appliances and large pieces of scrap metal, will be picked up curbside by appointment only. There is a \$25 charge per pickup appointment, with a limit of five items per pickup.

Items Not Collected Curbside Include:

- Asbestos (friable or non-friable)
- Automotive parts
- Construction debris
- Electronic waste, such as TVs and monitors
- Hazardous waste
- Large drums
- Loose trash or trash in paper bags
- Oil or propane tanks

Drop Off Facility

Manchester residents may dispose of many items not collected at curbside by transporting them to the City of Manchester Drop Off Facility, located at 500 Dunbarton Road. For hours of operation, materials accepted, fees and other information, consult www.manchesternh.gov or call (603) 624-6444.

Useful Information

Holidays

Refuse, recycling and yard waste are not collected on City holidays, and collection schedules may vary during holiday weeks. Generally, those residents whose collection day falls on a holiday should put their items out on the following day; all other residents should put their items out on the normally-scheduled day. Household Hazardous Waste Collection Events



The City of Manchester hosts two free Household Hazardous Waste Collection events for residents each year at the Drop Off Facility.

Collection events are held the second Saturdays of May and October, from 9 AM to 2 PM. Participants must show proof of residency, and wastes are accepted only in household amounts (typically, limited to 10 gallons/20 lbs).

Note Regarding Latex Paints

Latex paints are water-based and are not hazardous. To properly dispose of latex paints, remove the cover, add a drying agent, stir, let air-dry until solid, and put out with your regular trash for curbside pickup.
