The Center

Located on the west side of Manchester with easy access to public transportation, the 15,000 sq. foot facility provides a variety of space for both social programs and direct services. Connected to the Manchester Library's West Side Branch, and near West High School, the Facility offers expanded opportunities for learning for seniors, as well as well as intergenerational programs.

The Main floor of the Senior Center includes a parlor, small store and commercial kitchen. St. Joseph Community Services has a congregational meal program and also operates the Meals on Wheels program delivering meals to homebound seniors. The Center has a small residential kitchen for catering events and snacks, administrative offices, and a large multipurpose room which can accommodate up to 490 people. The large room can be divided into two smaller rooms if needed.

The ground floor includes a billiard / game room, an exercise room, two activity rooms, a craft room, and additional administrative space. Both floors are handicapped accessible. A 55 space parking lot with drop off space for Meals on Wheels drivers is located off the 2nd floor level.

The Campaign

A special fund raising campaign has focused on raising the final \$500,000 needed to secure the initial funding for the Center.

Corporations and businesses, individuals, families and foundations have contributed to the building fund drive in a variety of ways, including cash contributions and gifts. The campaign to help the Center continues as "Friends of the William B. Cashin Senior Active Center, Inc." A 501 C (3) organization developed to continue the community's good work. Cash contributions and gifts, tributes, and memorials are encouraged. Special recognition opportunities exist for donors, with all contributions being tax deductible.
