REGARDING: RESETTING OF FIRE ALARM SYSTEMS
DETAILS: (Description of specific orders to be followed)

BE ADVISED THAT IT IS UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON OR AUTHORITY TO TAMPER WITH ANY ALARM SYSTEM CONNECTED WITH THE FIRE DEPARTMENT.

AT NO TIME SHALL ANY PERSON: SILENCE, RESET, OR TAMPER WITH ANY INTERNAL ALARM SYSTEM OPERATING IN THE ALARM MODE.

CODE OF ORDINANCE REFERENCE: **CITY OF MANCHESTER CODE OF ORDINANCE SECTION 92.20, 92.23, 92.24:** Alarm system under the control of the Chief of the Fire Department or his designee.

The fire alarm system in the City shall be considered an apparatus connected with the Fire Department; and shall be under the full control of the Chief of the Fire Department, or his designee, as the apparatus commonly used by the Fire Department for the extinguishment of fires in the City.
