Incident Summary: Upon arrival 4 minutes after dispatch firefighters encountered the ranch style home 50% involved in fire. The occupants of the residence had self-evacuated before our arrival. Firefighters entered through the front door to begin to extinguish the blaze which was rapidly progressing through the entire home. Additional arriving crews assisted with back-up lines, ventilation in addition to search and rescue for any remaining occupants or pets.

Any Special Features: Solar panels on both sides of the roof presented a challenge for firefighters as they worked to extinguish the fire.

Extent of Damages: approx \$100,000.00 in damages
