

COMMITTEE ON BILLS ON SECOND READING

Chairman Craig called the meeting to order.

The Clerk called the roll.

Present: Aldermen Craig, O'Neil, Osborne, Corriveau

Absent: Alderman Arnold

Chairman Craig addressed item 3 of the agenda:

3. Ordinance Amendment:

"Amending Section 70.55 (D)(2) Residential Parking Permit Zone #2 by not allowing residents to park on Elm Street."

Alderman Craig stated in looking at the document, there are the bolded words 'parking on' and it is just a minor change.

Alderman Long stated in all the locations that we have zoned parking they don't allow parkign on Elm Street because of the businesses. That zone excludes Elm Street from parking. It is for the businesses. At that location there are businesses on Elm Street that utilize that parking.

Alderman Osborne asked it excludes, right?

Alderman Long replied correct, it excludes Elm Street.

Alderman O'Neil asked this allows, if I'm reading this correctly, residents of 555 Elm Street to not park.

Alderman Long stated it is a new residence. They just got their CO probably within the last six months.

Alderman O'Neil asked you are in support of this?

Alderman Long replied yes, I am.

On motion of Alderman O'Neil, duly seconded by Alderman Corriveau, it was voted that the Ordinance Amendment ought to pass and be referred to the Committee on Accounts, Enrollment and Revenue Administration.

Chairman Craig addressed item 4 of the agenda:

4. Ordinance Amendment:

"Amending Section 33.080 (A) Military Service of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Manchester by increasing the number of paid military leave days from ten to twenty days and deleting 33.080 (A)(1) related to attendance at military funerals."

On motion of Alderman Osborne, duly seconded by Alderman Corriveau, it was voted that the Ordinance Amendment ought to pass and be referred to the Committee on Accounts, Enrollment and Revenue Administration.

There being no further business, on motion of Alderman O'Neil, duly seconded by Alderman Osborne, it was voted to adjourn.
