

BOARD OF RECOUNT

November 15, 2003

At 9:00 AM the Board of Recount met in the Aldermanic Chambers of City Hall for the conduction of a recount of the Ward Six Alderman Race.

Chairman McDonough, Alderman Shea and Senator Martel were all present.

Procedures were outlined by the Deputy City Clerk, the ballot boxes were retrieved from the City Clerk's vault and opened. All ballots cast in the election held November 4, 2003 were counted. Two, two person teams were utilized. Each candidate had one observer for each team.

Following rulings from the Board of Recount, the remaining ballot protested was so marked and placed with all other ballot and related material into the boxes. The boxes were again sealed and certified by the Deputy City Clerk as to the contents which were agreed upon by observers for the candidates.

At the end of the counting Chairman McDonough advised that the results of the recount were as follows:

Mr. Porter having received the largest number of votes cast was denoted the winner.
