PROCEDURES FOR OBTAINING A PLACE OF ASSEMBLY PERMIT

HEALTH DEPARTMENT FIRST - 624-6466

1. Submit four (4) sets of floor plans drawn to scale detailing equipment layout, plumbing and seating.

BUILDING DEPARTMENT- 624-6475 - 1 City Hall Plaza, Manchester, NH

2. Complete building and site plans must be obtained with an affidavit from owner for permission to build and occupy, along with stamped prints of floor plan from the Health Department. Also, if you are going to put up a sign, you need a sketch of the sign to be approved by the Building Department.

FIRE DEPARTMENT – 624-6507 – 100 Merrimack Street, Manchester, NH

3. Go to Fire Prevention Bureau with a scaled diagram of seating, exits, exit lights, emergency lights, and extinguishers for approval. The Fire Prevention Bureau sets the seating capacity.

LIQUOR LICENSE - 271-3755 - Licensing 57 Regional Drive, Suite 8, Concord NH

4. Upon approval of the Health Department and Building Department, a Place of Assembly Permit will be issued from the Fire Department and a request for a liquor license will then be permissible.

CITY CLERK BUSINESS LICENSE - 624-6348 – 1 City Hall Plaza, Manchester, NH

5. Business engaged in certain activities, including but not limited to Sunday activities, dance, peddler, fairs, entertainment, or mechanical devices, must complete a Business License Application. The application, accompanied by this Food Permit Sign-off Form shall be obtained at the Business Licensing & Enforcement Division of the City Clerk's Office.

ROOMS & MEALS TAX – 230-5300 - 109 Pleasant St., Concord, NH

6. If you are selling food and beverages, please contact the NH Department of Revenue Administration to determine if you are required to register for the Rooms & Meals tax.
