Large Fight Outside Fire and Ice Hookah Bar Results in Five Arrests

On July 2nd at approximately 0130 hours, while working a uniform detail at USA Chicken and Biscuit 990 Elm Street, Officer Tennis' attention was drawn to a large crowd, approximately 30-40 individuals exiting out of Fire and Ice Hookah Bar located next door to the restaurant. The crowd began to push, shove and shout at one another resulting in a large scale brawl. Officer Tennis radioed for assistance in an attempt to stop the brawl. Several officers arrived to disperse the crowd. Five individuals remained engaged in tumultuous disorderly behavior. The following individuals were arrested:

Felony Criminal Threat Arrest

On July 4th at approximately 9:47 PM, Officer Callahan responded to Rock Rimmon Park for a criminal threat complaint involving a firearm. Officer Callahan spoke with the victim Nicholas Barna, 40 years of age from Manchester.

Barna reported that he was with a group of friends igniting fireworks from the top of Rock Rimmon. Barna was approached by a male subject using a flashlight to illuminate the area. The male with the flashlight, identified as Michael Flannery, 52 years of age of Manchester told Barna that fireworks are illegal in Manchester. Barna reported that a verbal argument ensued, resulting in Flannery removing a firearm holstered on his hip. Flannery reportedly threatened Barna by pointing the gun at him and stating that he would kill him.

Subsequent investigation led to Flannery's arrest for Felony Criminal Threatening. Michael Flannery will be arraigned on July 5th in the 9th Circuit District Manchester for Criminal Threat (Felony).

Purse Snatching

On July 4th at approximately 9:25 PM, a female patron of the Central Ale House 23 Central Street was seated outside on the patio area. The female had her purse on the table next to her. The male suspect walked into the patio area from the alleyway, grabbed a hold of her purse and fled on foot easterly toward Pine Street. A male patron gave chase, losing sight of the suspect in the area of 144 Lake Avenue. Responding officers located the victim's purse and its contents in the area of 144 Lake Avenue. The officers also located a red t-shirt on the ground believed to be discarded by the suspect.

Suspect Arraigned on Attempted Murder Charges

On March 24, 2016 Manchester Police responded to 21 Ashmere Drive in Manchester to speak with the resident in reference to someone shooting at their address. During the course of the investigation, information determined that at 0030 hours on March 23 2016, a juvenile resident of the address observed two subjects in a Blue Ford Fusion drive by the address several times. The juvenile resident exited the home and was standing in the yard when one of the subjects exited the Ford Fusion, stood in the street in front of the address and fired one round from a shot gun in the direction of the juvenile and the home. No one was injured during the incident.

The home was struck damaging a shutter and some vinyl siding. An extensive investigation ensued during which the subject responsible for the shooting was identified as Logan Howe 18 years old of Manchester. Howe has been charged with Attempted Homicide in connection with this incident. Howe was arraigned in the 9th Circuit District Manchester this morning and he is being held on \$250,000.00 bail. There is no further information being released on the case at this time.

Female Assaulted by Unknown Male in Alley Way

On July 3rd at approximately 2300 hours, Officers responded to the area of 396 Lake Avenue for a female assaulted by a male. The female victim reported that she had been knocked to the ground and choked by an unknown male. During the assault, the female attempted to use her pepper spray. The male suspect reached into her pockets and removed approximately \$23.00. Two females walking in the area were witness to the assault and came to the victim's aid. The suspect fled on foot and was described as a: White male in his twenties, black t-shirt with a white Chinese Symbol, dark grey cargo shorts and dark colored hat (possibly a scaly cap).
