Wanted Man Attempted to Flee Officers

Officer Casey Finn and Kyle Daly observed a wanted man duck into a Lake Avenue apartment at 5:00 p.m. yesterday. They watched Michael Matteuzzi, 34 of Manchester, New Hampshire enter the residence of 457 Lake Avenue, so the officers stopped in front of the address and spoke to a woman exiting the home. Matteuzzi was wanted on a probation/parole violation.

The woman stated several people, including Matteuzzi, were inside of the apartment. They spoke with Cheryl Calvo who resides on the first floor of the apartment house. The officers cleared the residence and located several individuals, including arrested Oscar LeClair, 36 of Danbury, New Hampshire. However, Matteuzzi was not one of the individuals who exited the apartment.

Officer Adam Cortese, who was outside of the apartment building, noticed a man jump out of a first floor window in an attempt to evade police. Officer Cortese was able to place him into custody as soon as he landed on the ground. He was positively identified as Michael Matteuzzi, who was taken into custody without incident.

Matteuzzi was charged with Violation of Bail Conditions, Resisting Arrest/Detention as well as the original warrant charge of Violation of Probation/Parole. He will appear in the 9th Circuit Court-Manchester on July 14, 2016.

LeClair was arrested on an electronic bench warrant from another agency, so no court information for him is available at this time.

Major Water Leak closes down portion of Bridge Street Extension
